Special Message to brothers wishing to help make a difference

Our council officers are attempting to reach out to our inactive members and ask that if you are able please call one of our officers listed on the front page of our newsletters and ask how you can help. We have 220 members in our council and only about 10% are actively supporting our activities. We are in need of brother knights to step into the roles of chairmen for our golf tournament and disability drive along with many other positions to support these and other functions.

We have begun to work with Paws Assistant dogs by donating money raised from our Disability Drive.

We ask each member to spend a a two hour slot in front of Publics and give out Tootsie Rolls and collect moneys for our supported charities.

Nearly 40 percent of our armed forces soldiers and a third of our Marines are exhibiting symptoms of PTSD. Statistics show that more than 120 veterans will commit suicide every week with another 1,000 veterans attempting suicide while under the care of the VA every month.

Nearly one in five service members returning from Iraq and Afghanistan (approximately 300,000) have post-traumatic stress disorder symptoms or major depression and 19 percent of post-Iraq and Afghanistan veterans are diagnosed with traumatic brain injuries.

In Paws SOAR program, Veterans are given an opportunity to explore new career paths, reintegrate into the community and restore their lives while committing to helping others through various therapy outlets and the training of service dogs for other veterans in need.

In Case of Death
