Announcement

Please keep available on your calendar Feb 1, 2, 3, 8, 9, or 10 to help with collection of donations for our annual disability drive. We will be staffing the four Publix stores in the Estero area on each of these dates from 8 AM to 6 PM each day. We will also need volunteers to collect after each Mass at Our Lady of Light on Feb 23 & 24.

We also still need two site captains for the Publix store at Sanibel and 41 on Feb 1,2,3 and OLOL on Feb 23 & 24.

We will be calling every knight to obtain a commitment for at least one 2 hour shift and more shifts if possible. 60 two hour shifts times two knights for each shift to cover for just the Publix stores. We typically cannot get 120 knights to work so we will need some double and triple shifts. Plus we will also need

five knights at each the 5 Masses at Our Lady of Light on Feb 23 & 24.

In past years some of our more giving knights have worked four or five and more shifts. Without these dedicated knights we would not be able to maintain our leadership position among the K of C councils in Florida.

Last year we were able to contribute over \$11,000 to the disabled children of Lee and Collier counties.

In Case of Death

At the death of a Brother Knight, notify the Grand Knight or the next in charge, who will then contact the family and offer sympathy and help from the Council. The Council member contacting the family should ask whether a wake will be held and if so, whether the family would like the Council to do a rosary service. If a Mass will be offered the family should be asked if they would like a resolution of condolence to be presented. Any ceremonial presentation requested should be done only with permission of the clergy. If the deceased Brother is a 4th Degree member, the Grand Knight will notify the Insurance Field Agent and the Faithful Navigator of the Assembly.
