The resolution to approve Council 2007-2008 Budget and thus give prior authorization for transfers of funds from the Treasury in excess of the current limits of Article VII. Sec.3 of the By-Laws (\$500) was unanimously approved by the membership. This resolution allows transfers of funds from the Treasury to the limits of the line-item amounts in the Expenses section of the Budget without a special vote for approval of each item.

A second resolution to eliminate further contributions to the building fund described in Article VII. Sec. 6 of the By-Laws and to eliminate this optional section from the By-Laws was also unanimously approved by the membership. Funds currently allocated to this account will be reallocated to the General Funds of the Council.

## In Case of Death

At the death of a Brother Knight, notify the Grand Knight or the next in charge, who will then contact the family and offer sympathy and help from the Council. The Council member contacting the family should ask whether a wake will be held and if so, whether the family would like the Council to do a rosary service. If a Mass will be offered the family should be asked if they would like a resolution of condolence to be presented. Any ceremonial presentation requested should be done only with permission of the clergy. If the deceased Brother is a 4th Degree member, the Grand Knight will notify the Insurance Field Agent and the Faithful Navigator of the Assembly.
