On Tuesday, November 11, we will be celebrating Veterans' Day. On this day, the Knights of Columbus will be hosting the Fifth Annual Veterans' Day Mass and Ceremonials at Sarasota National Cemetery. Bishop Frank Dewane will preside at the Mass, along with a good number of concelebrating priests from the Diocese of Venice.

This year, Mass will be celebrated in the Amphitheater of the newly constructed Patriot Plaza at the cemetery. This new venue, dedicated on June 28 of this year, is a truly impressive configuration, built to salute our deceased military benefactors, as well as to invite those who wish to honor them.

Our tradition has been to enhance the solemnity of the ceremonials with the active participation of a multi-Assembly Knights of Columbus Color Corps - drawn from throughout the Diocese, and led by state leaders of the Fourth Degree. Accordingly, we again wish to invite members of the Color Corps to participate in full regalia. We will provide a sizable tent, dedicated to their convenience. We cordially invite all Knights of Columbus Council and Assemblies members to attend the event, and to exchange pleasantries with Bishop Dewane afterwards. A large presence of the Knights is always appreciated and recognized as their endorsement and support of our efforts to honor those who have placed themselves in harm's way to defend our freedoms.

Our new venue, mostly under a translucent roof, will accommodate up to 2800 participants. And so, members, spouses, family and friends of all Councils and Assemblies are invited to participate in the Mass and to witness the associated ceremonials. (We have constructed a platform for displaying Council and Assembly Banners – please consider bringing them with you. Additionally, we will place a small white cross overlooking a nearby section of graves - which the Bishop will face while praying for our veteran brothers and sisters. Bishop Dewane will bless the dog tags suspended from this cross. Please bring your dog tags with you.)

Finally, please consider the continuance of our fraternal tradition of assisting with the financial underwriting of this event. Donations (to the Diocese of Venice) can be mailed to Eugene A. Dolecki, PGK, PFN, at 8325 Sailing Loop, Lakewood Ranch, FL 34202-2225.

The event committee of co-hosting Assemblies looks forward to your partnership in our Order's liturgical and military recognition of our veterans on their day.

In Case of Death

At the death of a Brother Knight, notify the Grand Knight or the next in charge, who will then contact the family and offer sympathy and help from the Council. The Council member contacting the family should ask whether a wake will be held and if so, whether the family would like the Council to do a rosary service. If a Mass will be offered the family should be asked if they would like a resolution of condolence to be presented. Any ceremonial presentation requested should be done only with permission of the clergy. If the deceased Brother is a 4th Degree member, the Grand Knight will notify the Insurance Field Agent and the Faithful Navigator of the Assembly.
